- Tester: The product of a project would be much more stable, if it would be test by another person before it is released.
- User Guide Writer: A user guide written by a user, not a developer is most of the time much better to understand from other users
- Developer: There are many roles in which you can support us. Develop new features is only one role of a Developer. Automatic Tests, Bug finding & fixing, Code review, ... are also roles in which a developer can support the projects.
